Plans are well advanced as Sweden prepares to welcome member nations of the World Transplant Games Federation to the 2011 World Games being held in **Göteborg, Sweden 17-24 June 2011.**

To be eligible to participate in the sports at the World Transplant Games athletes must have had an organ transplant - kidney, liver, heart, lung (single or double), bone marrow or pancreas (12 months prior to commencement of Games) ; be between the ages of 5-85 years old.

Supporters are encouraged to join athletes as part of the team. All team members – athletes and supporters must be financial members **of the New Zealand Transplant Games Association Inc.** If you are not a member of the Association join now!! The annual sub is \$35 per person (free if under 18 years of age)

The cost per team member to attend and participate in the 2011 World Transplant Games is approximately NZ\$5,000 (over 18 years of age). The cost is less for under 18 years of age. (Athletes under 18 years of age must be accompanied by an adult). The cost covers airfares, accommodation, registration, meals during the games.

The 2011 Games will use an online registration system and athletes wishing to attend the Games will be required to complete the online pre-registration form which will be available soon.

**A deposit of \$100 per person (adult or child)** is required by **30<sup>th</sup> September 2010** to confirm your interest to attend the 2011 World Transplant Games. (The deposit is refundable up to 14 March 2011.)
